It is a legal requirement that the club obtain consent to use photographs of players in the press, programmes and other club publicity material e.g. the SYFC website. Please tick the box if you do NOT give your consent.

Note that the signing-on fee is to cover coaching, insurance, use of our facilities and equipment (for example, playing field use, kits, balls, etc.) – it does not guarantee any player matches. Signing-on fees are non-refundable.

Match fees are charged in addition to the signing-on fee and for season 2010-2011 will be £2 (U11 and below), £2.50 (U12 – U16) and £4 (U18).

Note that all kit belongs to, and must be returned to, the club. Note also that all fines incurred by a player must be paid by the player, e.g. for a caution or sending-off.

The club operates its own disciplinary policy, which will be implemented in addition to any sanctions imposed by any of the Leagues that we play in or the Gloucestershire Football Association. For details of our disciplinary policy refer to the club website or ask your child's team manager for a copy.

The committee of Slimbridge Youth Football Club reserves the right to ask any player who is not abiding by the club's disciplinary policy or player's code of conduct to leave the club.

When playing for Slimbridge YFC your child is covered by the public liability insurance that the club purchases from Gloucestershire F.A. Please note however that this excludes insurance for "player-to-player" injuries. See the club website for details. You will need to take out personal insurance if you wish your child to be insured against such injuries.
